

Information for B.A./B.S./MPA degree

This program makes it possible for qualified students to earn a baccalaureate degree while also pursuing a Master of Public Administration degree from the School of Public Affairs and Administration. The program is designed for the highly motivated student who decides at an early stage in his or her studies to pursue a career in public administration.

- Program requirements:
 - 94 undergraduate credits in arts or sciences curriculum (MPA is 42 credits total)
 - Any undergraduate major in arts or sciences
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
 - GRE test score (junior year)
 - Application for early admission to MPA Program (junior year, second semester)
 - Submission of all necessary documents for admission: resume, personal statement, 3 letters of recommendation, UG transcript,

- Program completion:
 - 12 credits of MPA degree with B or better average used to complete UG degree
 - 30 additional MPA credits at B (3.0) or better complete the MPA degree.
