- **Admissions requirements**
 - 7+ years' managerial experience in public or non-profit sectors
 - Detailed resume
 - 3.0 GPA from prior degree at post-secondary institution (or GRE scores)
 - Official transcript from each post-secondary institution attended (bachelor's degree from recognized institution required)
 - Three letters of recommendation (at least one from current employer or supervisor)
 - International students: minimum TOEFL score of 90 or IELTS score of 6.5
- Program tuition, fees, and all course materials **total approximately \$40,000**, but employers often provide financial support
- **Build worldwide network of experienced colleagues and professionals**
 - Upon graduation, students earn membership in the School of Public Affairs and Administration Alumni Network, with access to professional development, mentoring, and community engagement activities
- Earn a graduate degree from Rutgers University **completely online** with completion of **30 credits from 10 courses in only 2 years**
