A Certificate in Appreciative Inquiry (Ai) from Rutgers University–Newark’s School of Public Affairs and Administration (SPAA) is issued to participants upon the completion of the following coursework:

- Participate in initial workshops in which students learn how to apply Ai in the public and nonprofit sectors
- Design, conduct, and prepare a paper about an Ai project of choice
- Participate in concluding workshops featuring advanced Ai concepts and practices and interactively share lessons learned from the Ai projects and leadership interviews

Program Cost
