Participants will attend interactive lectures (simultaneously translated into English) from senior level Seoul government officials, participate in field trips to government sites, and have ample time for sightseeing and learning about the culture of Korea throughout the stay.

- 5. Students purchase the flight ticket at their own expenses, but all expenses for lodging and meals are funded by the City of Seoul
