Seoul, Korea May 18-24, 2019 MPA Elective

Rutgers-SPAA announces a unique and exciting opportunity for graduate students.

This 3-credit, graduate-level elective course immerses students in the inner workings of the City of Seoul, Korea - one of the most technologically advanced cities in the world. Participants will attend interactive lectures (simultaneously translated into English) from senior level Seoul government officials, participate in field trips to government locations, and have ample time for sightseeing and learning about the culture of Korea throughout the stay.

- 2. Selected students must arrive in Seoul on May 18, 2019, and take lectures during the period May 18-24, 2019.
- 3. Selected students should attend preparative classes in SPAA during March and April - 5 Saturdays from 2:00 - 4:00pm (subject to change)
- Students pay the regular Rutgers course tuition fee in "the 2019 summer" and purchase the flight ticket (All lodging and meals expenses are funded by the City of Seoul)
- 5. After the trip to Korea, the participants are required to submit a research paper (will be discussed in the preparative classes).
