

Human Resources Management (20:834:523:90) [3 credits]

Course Description

The course addresses public sector human resources management from multiple perspectives, including theoretical, legal, political, policy, and practical. It covers the important contemporary issue of diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI), as well as other critical issues such as public sector labor relations, performance management, ethics, and privatization.

Learning Objectives

Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:

- Select and explain statutory and constitutional law for public employees that apply to current public personnel administration issues.
- Apply human resource management skills that demonstrate effective skills in leadership, communications, and motivation.
- Relate theory about public personnel administration to current issues.

Requirements
